

Moon Journal Assignment

[From the course syllabus] *Keep a “running journal” of your observations and questions related to the moon. Try to observe the moon every weeknight and at least once on the weekend. Bring your journal to class each day (Note: An actual booklet or notebook is required for this assignment). Submit your journal on April 23.*

1. Describe what you see when you observe the moon? (e.g., not visible or visible, or partly visible; cloudy or clear; large or small; bright or faint; full or half or crescent; if a crescent, what direction does it face?). Be sure to draw a picture of what it looked like.
2. Mention any questions that occurred to you as you observed (or afterwards).
3. You might try using a digital camera (if you have one) to capture pictures of what you observed.
4. More advice and instructions may be added as the course progresses. Samples of what other students have said or done related to this assignment will be posted at the Blackboard site for this course.
